

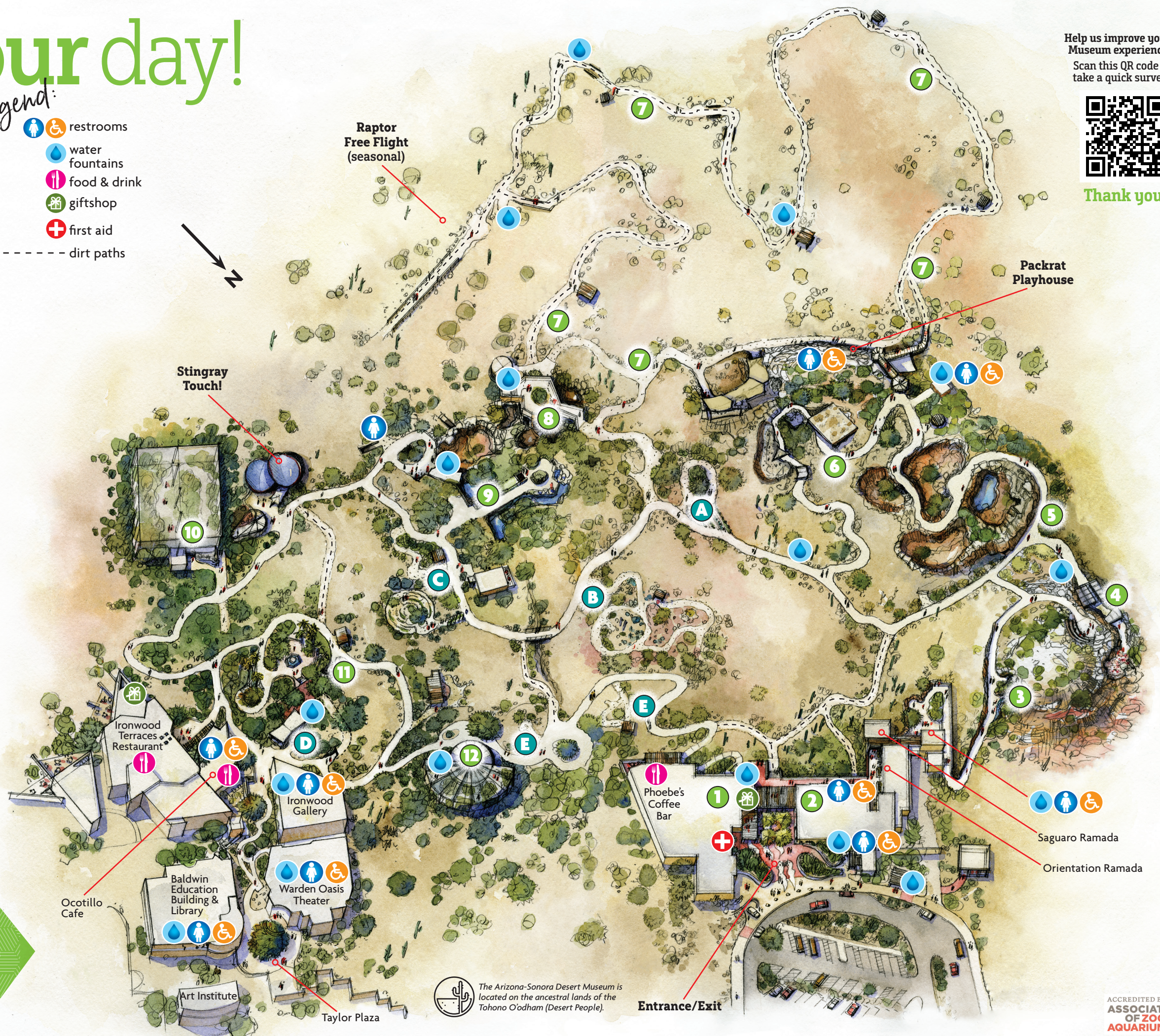

Arizona gems & minerals
- 4 Ancient Arizona & Sonorasaurus**
Investigate prehistoric Arizona and learn about the Sonorasaurus dinosaur.
- 5 Mountain Woodland**
mountain lion, black bear, Mexican gray wolves, mule deer
- 6 Desert Grassland**
grasshopper mouse, snakes, burrowing owl, great blue heron, prairie dogs
- 7 Desert Loop Trail**
Life on the Rocks (multi-species exhibit), coyotes, javelina, lizards
- 8 Cat Canyon**
ocelot, bobcat, coati, gray fox
- 9 Riparian Corridor**
river otter, beaver, bighorn sheep, fish & aquatic invertebrates
- 10 Birds of the Sonoran Desert**
This large free-flight aviary features a variety of species native to the Sonoran Desert region.
- 11 Life Underground**
Burrowing animals
- 12 Hummingbird Aviary**
Enjoy the antics of multiple hummingbird species!
